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Your application was selected for review in a process called *Verification*. In this process, your Financial Aid Counselor will compare information from your FAFSA with your (and your parents' or spouse's) actual tax return data, income and asset information. The law states we have the right to ask you for this information. If there are differences, the financial aid office must correct your FAFSA which may affect your financial aid. Complete this worksheet and submit it to Erwin's financial aid office as soon as possible to avoid delays in processing your financial aid.

**What you should do:**

1. Check with Financial Aid Administrator for requested documents.
2. Complete and sign this worksheet:
  - a. Dependent students: you and the parent who signed your FAFSA
  - b. Independent students: you and your spouse
3. Submit the completed worksheet and any other documents requested to the financial aid office.

**Section 1: High School Completion Status**

Your Financial Aid Counselor is required to verify your high school completion status. To avoid delays in processing your aid, students should ensure their high school submits an official copy of your final high school transcript to Erwin Technical Center as soon as possible after graduation. An official copy will come to Erwin in a sealed envelope, with the official high school seal and will include your graduation date. Official results showing a passing score on the General Educational Development (GED) test may be accepted in place of high school graduation. *If Erwin Technical Center has a copy of your official final high school transcript or GED scores on file, no further documentation is required.*
